I love how literal she is! I will never forget when Destiny was born, on Nov. 30th. I met her the next day. Then, the next day, in the same hospital, my husband and I found out....that I had lost my baby. I'd been pregnant for about three months.

In Peter Pan, J.M. Barrie wrote, 'When the first baby laughed for the first time, the laugh broke into a thousand pieces and they all went skipping about, and that was the beginning of fairies. And now when every new baby is born its first laugh becomes a fairy.'
But what if your baby isn't born?

One time I was taking [Destiny] to the bathroom at her house. I thought she might want some privacy as my husband was in the kitchen right by the bathroom - and so I shut the door behind us - and immediately, she just started laughing and running around the bathroom for several minutes - I thought, 'Is she ok?' and then realized that that's what people say to me all the time,
